OVERNIGHT SUBTROPICAL RAINFOREST CAMP!

As part of Green Friends Australia's- **Living Consciously** campaign and in line with our focus of **The Preservation and Regeneration of Forests** we are planning an **Overnight Camp in the Border Ranges National Park.**

Border Ranges National Park is a World Heritage listed subtropical rainforest park. It stretches 85 kilometers from east to west. Together with the McPherson Ranges, the Springbrook Plateau and the Nightcap National Park, Border Ranges National Park forms part of the caldera of the Mount Warning shield volcano (the largest caldera in the southern hemisphere). It hosts spectacular views, pristine rainforests, waterfalls plunging into deep gorges, sparkling creeks, steep scarps and rugged ridges.



We plan to camp at Forest Tops Camping area situated in a grassy clearing amongst the trees. We'll meditate together, picnic, chant, bush walk, and plan to melt into the forest as we bring reverence for the trees into our hearts.

Come join us. Everyone is welcome!

Date: Saturday May 7th and Sunday May 8th.

There is a cost of \$5 per night for adults and \$3 a night per child for camping in the park and vehicles need to buy a pass to the park which costs \$7.
