Getting To Noosa Leisure Centre

Noosa Leisure Centre is located in central Noosaville on the Sunshine Coast Queensland. Set in beautiful parkland, it is moments from the Noosa river and just 10 minutes from our famous beaches.

Noosa Leisure Centre is located at **9 Wallace Drive Noosaville**, just over one and a half hour's drive from Brisbane City and Brisbane Airport, or 25 minutes from Sunshine Coast Airport, Maroochydore.

There is free parking at Noosa Leisure Centre and the surrounding Wallace Park precinct.

Airport transfers

Transport from Brisbane International or Brisbane Domestic Airport.

- Shared shuttle service (\$65), one stop shuttle (\$115) or private transfer (\$285) services. These methods are "door to door", taking you directly to your accommodation:

Transport from Sunshine Coast Airport (Maroochydore)

By car

From Brisbane City Centre, Northern or North Western suburbs:

Travel time approximately 1½ hours

- Head North out of the city, via Gympie Rd (A3) to Bruce Hwy (M1), following the signs to Sunshine Coast.

Eastern, Southern or South Western suburbs (including the Gold Coast):

To bypass the City, it's easier to go via the Gateway Motorway (M1), which later becomes the Bruce Hwy (M1) toward the Sunshine Coast.

- The Ipswich Motorway (M7), Logan Motorway (M2) and Pacific Motorway (M1 - from the Gold Coast) all provide access to the Gateway Motorway. Tolls apply.

From Brisbane Airport: Travel time approximately 1½ hours

- On leaving the airport take the main road (Moreton Drive) towards the City. Keep to the left lanes and take exit 'Sunshine Coast'. This will lead onto the Gateway Motorway (M1) heading North toward the Bruce Highway (M1) and Sunshine Coast.

For all routes

- From the Bruce Highway take Exit 224 to Eumundi
- Continue on the Eumundi/Noosa Rd (Route 12) following this through Doonan and into Noosaville
- Continue straight at the Beckman's Road roundabout as well as the next 4 roundabouts (Route 12).
- Turn left into Wallace Drive after the big blue 'Wallace Park' road sign.

Public Transport to Noosa

Brisbane City Centre to Noosa Leisure Centre Noosaville via train and connecting bus

Trains leave Brisbane throughout the day. The trip (including connecting bus) takes approximately 3 hours and costs \$19.96 adult or \$9.98 child / concession with a Go Card.

- Sunshine Coast line trains leave Brisbane City stations (Roma St, Central, Brunswick St and Bowen Hills) heading towards Nambour (approx 1 hour and 49 minute from Central).
- From other suburbs on Brisbane's Northside you can catch a Caboolture train and transfer to the Sunshine Coast train at Caboolture.
- Exit train at Nambour station. The bus depot is just outside the terminal to the right hand side.
- Board the 631 bus, towards Noosa Junction Station
- Exit bus at Hilton Terrace, Tewantin-Noosa Bowls Club. You are now next door to Ivory Palms Resort and across the road from Cayman Quays. This stop is approximately 700 metres from Noosa Leisure Centre.
- Bus 631 continues down Gympie Tce where further accommodation in the area is located.

Note: Bald Hills station is a 10 minute drive from Brisbane's public program venue (Eatons Hill). Catch a taxi or Uber to Bald Hills station and get any train that goes to Caboolture. Then transfer at Caboolture to a Sunshine Coast train (times below).

Sunshine Coast Public Transport

The best train station to connect to the Noosa area is Nambour. The Noosa area is serviced by busses, winding around our waterways, beaches, and many roundabouts!

Most Buses run from a central point called Noosa Junction Bus terminal. Timetables and routes can be found at translink.com.au.

Fares:

You will need to purchase a 'Go Card' at the train station and add money to it to cover your fares. They can also be purchased from any 7 Eleven in QLD and selected retailers. Cost to buy the Go Card is \$10 adults, \$5 child, concession or senior. Paper tickets are available but the fare costs more.

Use the card to tap on and off at each station or bus you use. The fare is deducted from the balance on your card.

Private Bus Companies

Premier Motor Service

Buses operate once a day from Brisbane to Noosa Junction*. The journey takes approximately 2 hours 20 minutes and costs \$24.
